

DATA PROTECTION NOTICE**HANDLING OF END USER DATA IN CASE OF SALES VIA INTERMEDIARY**

Ring-Autó Kft. would like to inform through this document the parties concerned about the data handling rules by taking into account the relevant laws and our own data protection guidelines.

This notice only contains information about the specific data handling activity. Additional information required by the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679/EU is included in the General Data Protection Notice of the Data Controller, which is available on our website <https://www.ringautokft.hu/adatvedelem>

1. The Data Controller

2. Description of data handling activities

As a brand dealer, Ring-Autó Kft. is entitled to sell certain vehicles to end users who involve EU intermediaries. The Data Controller is obliged to ensure that the EU intermediary has valid authorisation issued by the end user prior to purchasing and receiving the vehicle. The authorisation must include the end user's name, address, signature, and the date of the signature. The Data Controller must retain a copy of the authorisation for 5 years in accordance with the brand dealer contract.

Scope of data handled	Goal of handling data	Basis of handling data
name, address, signature	to certify the authorisation for purchasing a vehicle in accordance with the brand dealer contract	According to Article 6 (1) (f) of the Regulation, the Data Controller has a legitimate interest in being able to demonstrate compliance with the brand dealer contract to the Importer, and for this purpose, the personal information of the end-user.

The Data Controller stores the data until February 28 of the 6th calendar year after the conclusion of the contract. The duration of data handling is determined by the provisions of the brand dealer contract and the Data Controller's culling practice.

3. Your rights

Your rights are determined by the Regulation, the most important of which are:

- You can request access to your personal data from the Data Controller, correct them, delete them or limit their handling, and object to the handling of such personal data, and you have the right to data portability.
- In the case of data handled with consent, you may revoke your consent at any time, without giving any reason, but this does not affect the lawfulness of the data handling before the withdrawal of consent.

You can exercise your rights by contacting the Data Controller at the above-mentioned contact details. If you submit a request, the Data Controller will respond in writing as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days. For further information, please contact the Data Controller at the contact details provided above.

In case of an alleged violation of your rights, you can file a complaint with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (address: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11., +36-1-391-1400, ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu) or turn to the court. The trial falls within the jurisdiction of the court. The trial can also be initiated before the court of your place of residence, depending on your choice (you can view the list of courts and their contact details through the following link: <http://birosag.hu/torvenyszekek>)
